The Award

The National Agricultural Award

The Prize

The National Agricultural Award trophy, medal and certificate together with honorary membership of the Society are presented at the Royal Show.

The Candidate

The award will be made to an individual to recognise an outstanding contribution to the advancement of agriculture in the UK. The award may be made for a particular achievement or the culmination of work over a number of years.

The Submission

The submission should include the name, qualifications and age of the candidate and a description (of not more than 500 words) explaining why the candidate should be considered for this award.

In particular judges will be looking for candidates who have contributed something to agriculture or rural industry above and beyond that demanded by their job or position. Amongst other achievements this may include:

- work as a spokesperson for the industry
- development of a new idea or process
- encouraging partnership working
- providing new information
- activity to improve public perception of the countryside / rural industry
- improving communication within the industry or between rural industry and the general public.
